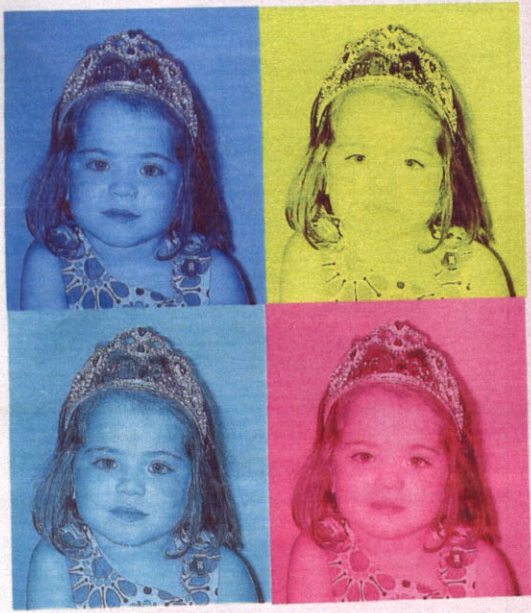

## It's Easy To . . .

# Turn your favorite photo into a pop-art masterpiece!



## What you'll need

- ❑ Favorite photo—close-ups work best
- ❑ Computer with a photo editing program, or access to a copy shop
- ❑ Straight-edge paper trimmer or metal straight edge and X-Acto knife
- ❑ White cardstock cut to 8"x10"
- ❑ Glue stick
- ❑ Narrow black frame for an 8"x10" picture

A little computer magic is all it takes to create a stunning Warhol-like work of "heart"!

**1** If using a computer, print a favorite photo four times, each time in black and a



single color. We chose blue, chartreuse, teal and fuchsia. Print photos 3 1/4" x 3 3/4". No computer? Take your photo to a copy shop and have four copies printed, each in a different color. There won't be any black, so the look will be slightly different, but it will be just as impressive.



**2** Carefully cut out the photos, using a straight-edge paper trimmer or a straight edge and X-Acto knife.



**3** Arrange the photos, edges touching, in the center of your cardstock. Use glue stick liberally to stick them down. Place picture in frame.
